AM in sympathy with the cemetery improvement work, but I certainly think that some attention should be given by the Mesa County commissioners, who really own the plot, or by the Improvement Association, if the commissioners won't do it, to that desolate, pitiful-looking, neglected little burying ground of the paupers, which is off under the hill from the big cemeteries," said a prominent cattleman to The Sentinel yesterday.

"Even if just the fence around that lonely group of graves were fixed, it would be a big help," he said.

And this citizen is right.

The Sentinel proposes to see that some attention is given the pauper graves under the hill,

And it is up to the Mesa County commissioners to help in this matter.

"While those poor folks died penniless and friendless, and while I know it is very hard for the ladies who are caring for the public cemeteries to do work in this little pauper plot, because it is removed so far from the public cemeteries; still I feel that something ought to be done. Those folks buried there are on a level with all the rest when the grave is reached, and they are likely to come out of the canon or off the hill, when Gabriel calls, just as quickly as any of the rest of as," concluded the cattleman.
