### A Sudden Death.

Our citizens were startled on Wednesday morning by the announcement of the sudden death of the wife of Mr. Joseph Reither. From Dr. Ingersoll, the attending physician, we learned the following facts: Mrs. Reither was subject to attacks of heart trouble, and he had been called upon frequently to treat her for this trouble. On Tuesday afternoon he was again called in to see the lady, and found her suffering from her old trouble. He administered an injection of morphine, the usual quantity. He did not see her again as he was called to the country that night and did not get back until quite late. He is of the opinion that she had another attack of the disease while under the influence of the morphine, from which she died.

Mr. and Mrs. Reither were married about a year ago, she coming from St. Louis for that purpose. The couple have lived happily together, and Mr. Reither feels his loss deeply; the more so because he was absent from home when his wife died. She was buried on Thursday at the Orchard Mesa cemetery.
