

## George Bewsher Fatally Burned At Pomona Farm

George William Bewsher, Pomona farmer, died at 5:30 p. m. Monday at St. Mary's hospital from severe burns he received when gasoline, sprayed on his clothing from a break in the connection of the weed burner he was using, ignited.

Mr. Bewsher was burning weeds with a pipe-tank apparatus, and his grandson, Ernest Beard of Divide Creek, near Rifle, was helping him. The hose slipped off the pipe, and the gasoline under air pressure, sprayed Mr. Bewsher's clothing. The flames from the burner and the weeds flashed to the man instantly, and the
