

2D ACCIDENT VICTIM DIED LAST NIGHT

Tony Cordova Died at Fruita Hospital Last Night at 10 O'clock

Tony Cordova died last night at 10 o'clock at the Fruita hospital of injuries he received on Saturday night when he was struck by a passing automobile as he worked repairing a tire on the main highway near Loma. His companion, Joe Gallegos, died early Sunday morning and his funeral was held on Monday.

Both men were well known residents of the lower valley district. Both had children in that school in their district, and they are spoken of by their neighbors and friends as fine men who were working hard to support their families of several children.

They had been employed in hauling beets from the Herman Sheets place north of Loma to the Loma dump. For the past several years the families had lived in this district and the fathers had worked in the sugar beets.

Neither of the men regained consciousness before death. Cordova, whose injuries were thought to be less serious than those Gallegos received, was able to talk only a little on Saturday night, but neither was able to tell about the accident. They were fatally injured but it was announced earlier that Cordova had chances of recovery until examination disclosed serious internal injuries which were the cause of his death.

Antoni Cordova was born in Walsenburg, Colorado, on October 26, 1894, passing away at the age of 37 years. He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Sadalia Cordova, and six children, the oldest one of whom is 13 years of age.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Starks-Dellarman mortuary at Fruita. Burial will be in the Loma cemetery.
