

## Funeral Services For Jim Maldonado Tonight At Fruita

Jim Maldonado, 28, lower valley beet worker, passed away early this morning at the home of his brother, Zack, at Fruita, after a brief illness brought on by tonsillitis and septic throat.

Funeral services will be held this evening at 7 o'clock at the Pentecostal church in Fruita. Burial will take place at 1 o'clock tomorrow afternoon at the Pentecostal cemetery at Loma.

The deceased is survived by his widow, Faye Maldonado, and a 2-months-old daughter, Louisa. He had been employed under contract in charge of beet fields of William Knapp, lower valley rancher. He was born in Guadalupita, New Mexico.

Maldonado was the object of a countywide search a year ago this month after an automobile he was driving struck and killed Joe Gallegos and Tony Cordova on the main highway near Loma.
