

Death of Miss Childs.

Mise Lue H. Childs, one of the teachers at Teller institute, who has been sick for the past several weeks at the hospital of the sisters of charity, died there today at noon.

Miss Childs took sick with a very aggravated case of typhoid fever about two weeks or more ago. She was at once taken to St. Marys hospital where every possible attention was given the young woman. She was attended every day by Dr. Bull, who put forth every effort to save the young life, but it was of no avail, the constitution of the deceased was a frail one and she succumbed to the grim reaper.

Miss Childs was from North Fairfield, Ohio. She had only been a teacher at the school a comparatively short time and was much beloved by scholars and her associate teachers.

A brother of the deceased arrived in the city last week from Crestline and he added his care to that of the physicians and sisters who nursed the young ady, but to no avail.

The body will not be shipped home but buried from the undertaking parlors of A. L. Gourley at 2:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. Interment in the Orchard Mesa cemetery.
