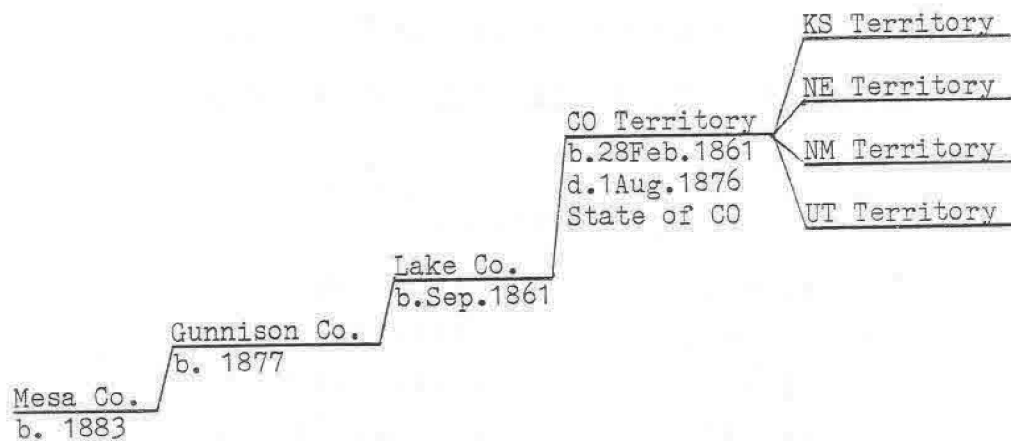

## *- Colorado -*

*(When the 1860 U.S. Census was taken)*

In 1860, when the U.S. Census was taken, Colorado was divided among the four Territories of Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, and Utah, as follows:

Kansas owned that portion lying between  $38^{\circ}30'$  and  $40^{\circ}$  latitude, from the Continental Divide eastward to  $102^{\circ}$  longitude, plus the territory lying east of  $103^{\circ}$  longitude and south of  $38^{\circ}30'$  latitude shown as Washington County, Kansas, on the map below. (Kansas created the Counties of Arapahoe and Washington in 1855; however, they were never formally organized.)

Nebraska claimed the area lying north of  $40^{\circ}$  latitude, from the Continental Divide eastward to  $102^{\circ}$  longitude.

New Mexico held that portion lying south of  $38^{\circ}30'$  latitude, from the Continental Divide in the West, to  $103^{\circ}$  longitude in the East.

Utah claimed the remaining area — everything west of the Continental Divide.

This map represents Colorado as it was when the 1860 U.S. Census was taken.
