## (When the 1860 U.S. Census was taken)

In 1860, when the U.S. Census was taken, Colorado was divided among the four Territories of Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, and Utah, as follows:

- Kansas owned that portion lying between 38°30' and 40° latitude, from the Continental Divide eastward to 102° longitude, plus the territory lying east of 103° longitude and south of 38°30' latitude shown as Washington County, Kansas, on the map below. (Kansas created the Counties of Arapahoe and Washington in 1855; however, they were never formally organized.)
- Nebraska claimed the area lying north of 40° latitude, from the Continental Divide eastward to 102° longitude.
- New Mexico held that portion lying south of 38°30' latitude, from the Continental Divide in the West, to 103° longitude in the East.
- Utah claimed the remaining area everything west of the Continental Divide.

This map represents Colorado as it was when the 1860 U.S. Census was taken.
