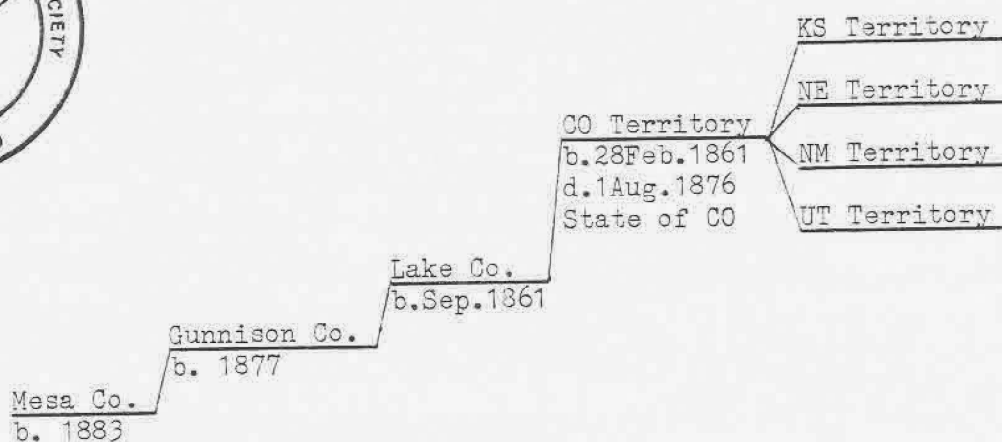
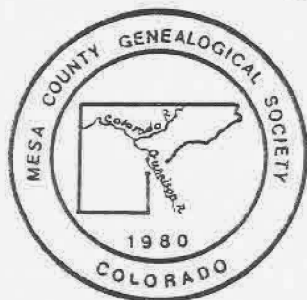

MYSTERY BOXES INTEREST GENEALOGISTS

The U. S. Government has been holding the contents of more than 23,000 bank safety deposit boxes since the depression bank failures of 1930-1934. The contents of many of these boxes is not known, but a random examination reveals such items as personal and financial papers, jewelry, pocket watches, false teeth, coins, insurance policies and family histories. A list of the names of the box renters is published in The Federal Register, Vol. 48, page 30012, dated June 29, 1983. Ask for it in the Reserve section of Mesa County Public Library. If you believe you might have a claim to any of the stored items you may file a claim according to the directions given in The Federal Register article. CLAIMS MUST BE FILED BEFORE JUNE, 1984.

St. Joseph's Catholic Church is 100 years old this year. Father Robert Servant became the first resident pastor, in 1884. Daily Sentinel reporter, Mary Louise Giblin, has written a history of the church, which will be given to the parishioners. The church is located at White Ave. and 3rd in Grand Junction, CO.

MESA COUNTY CEMETERIES

First Babe is Dead in The Big Park (1)

This was the headline for an article in the January 13, 1911 Grand Junction Daily Sentinel and on February 11th a report was written about a mass meeting in Big Park (now called Glade Park) to select a site and start a cemetery. The three month old baby of Mr. & Mrs. Warren Carpenter was dead, "the first born and the first to die in the new Community". (2) Warren, more often referred to as Worry or Wary, and Mossie Carpenter came to Glade Park from Oklahoma about 1908, or soon thereafter. He was one of four sons of John Carpenter who came first to Fruita and then took a homestead in Glade Park. Evidently all four boys followed their father to Mesa County.

They were active members in The Brethren Church and according to church history records "ground for the Church was donated by Wary Carpenter, son of Bro. John Carpenter; ground for a cemetery was also donated". (3) The gravestone inscriptions in the Glade Park Cemetery have been recorded by The Mesa Genealogical Society and only the one for Virgil C. Carpenter, b. 30 May 1909, d. 4 May, 1927 was found legible for any member of the family. It is believed that there are at least four other Carpenters buried there, but traces of the graves are gone or are no longer marked. We would appreciate hearing from anyone who has knowledge of early burials that may not be accounted for with gravestones in the Glade Park Cemetery.
