


 PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I mentioned in the last Quarterly about the importance of developing good genealogical research techniques and habits. Even more important is how soon we develop these habits. Before getting too far along in our research it is a good idea to choose a notekeeping system by examining the different methods used by other genealogists. You might want to talk to members of the Society who have been researching their genealogy for a number of years, or read a few of the how-to books.

There are many forms available to aid your organizational techniques and two widely used forms are the pedigree charts and family group sheets. When using a family group sheet it is a good idea to briefly document on the bottom or back of the sheet, the source for your data. Some other forms you may want to consider are a research calendar, research extraction sheet and a correspondence log.

The research calendar will allow you to show the date of your research, the source used and numerous helpful notations. Later on this form can aid you in relocating the source of your data, help you to avoid duplication and can give others, who may be reading your records, information about the source.

Since we do not always wish to photocopy the data from every source, a research extraction sheet can help organize the data. Many of us are already using special census extraction sheets for the different census years.

Once you begin to write a lot of letters and inquiries, a correspondence log will come in quite handy. It can contain information about who you wrote to, when you wrote, whether you sent money and the responses you received.

Try to pick the system and forms that will fit your needs and it will make your genealogical research easier and more enjoyable.

## GRANDMA'S SAMPLER

### Genealogical Data from Samplers



AUGUSTA FOSTER

The search for names, dates and places doesn't always lead the genealogist to yellowed pages and fragile documents. Sometimes it can be delicate pieces of needlework, framed and hanging on a wall.

There was a time in history when samplers were popular, especially among young girls learning to do needlework or looking for a way to display their skills with the needle. We find samplers in America, England, Spain, France and a few of the other European countries.

Such a genealogical gem adds a bit more proof to the records of Donna Roberts.

Augusta Foster, age 9, stitched the sampler reproduced below. The original is made of linen, embroidered in pale blue, elaborately designed with rosebuds and the alphabet written in three different types of printing. Augusta is Donna's great grandmother, listed on the ancestor chart that follows.


