

### FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO ARE WORKING ON THE OBITUARY FILES AT THE LIBRARY

1. Park in the front parking lot. Do NOT park in the back as you will be taking a space belonging to the library employees.
2. Enter the library through the BACK DOOR. Do not knock on the front door to gain entry.
3. Sign in on the LOG SHEET downstairs.

For those of you that are typing obituaries at home, keep track of your hours. These need to be turned into the library or if you like, you may give them to me at the meetings and I will turn them in as a group. The library keeps track of all volunteer hours. If you have not kept track of your hours, you can list the months that you have typed obits and estimate the time that you have spent. (I usually take about 3 to 3 1/2 hours to type one month.) If you file them at the library, you should sign in on the Log Sheet set up for volunteers. If you don't know where it is , ask one of the reference librarians downstairs. Keep up the good work.

FEDERAL CENSUSES - INTERESTING FACTS Vol #22 No.1 Jun 1989 CT Nutmegger  
1840 Minnesota Federal census was enumerated with the Clayton Co., IA census.

1860 Montana and northeastern part of Colorado Federal census was recorded as "Unorganized Territory" in the Nebraska 1860 census. The rest of Colorado was listed with Kansas census.

1820 and 1830 Wisconsin census is listed with those of Michigan.

1860 Nevada census is listed with Utah census.

1860 census schedule for the present state of Oklahoma was included with Arkansas and was known as "Indian Lands".

### TWENTIETH CENTURY CENSUS PROBLEMS

Unknown to most researchers until recently, all of the original census schedules from 1900 through 1980 were destroyed after they were microfilmed in the early 1950's. Why were they destroyed? Because of an agreement that was signed between the Census Bureau and the National Archives and Records Administration permitting it. Ordinarily this wouldn't be a problem. But at the time the microfilming was done, filming techniques were not as advanced as they are now, and the film quality is very poor with many pages being practically unreadable. Without the original schedules, little can be done to improve the film quality now. Since the later census years are not presently available to researchers, we can only hope that the film quality will be better than 1910's is.

What is the solution to this problem? Write letters to the following people asking that the agreement be repealed, are at least re-studied in view of improved preservation techniques and that money be budgeted for their preservation and also for better or improved quality control when the microfilming is done of the 1990 census and all future census schedules. Your letters need to be written to the Secretary of Commerce, Robert A. Mosbacher; the National Archivist, Don W. Wilson, as well as your senators and representatives in Congress. With barely seven months remaining before census takers begin canvassing households for the 1990 census, researchers need to get busy and write soon. Call your local public or college library to get the names and addresses of your senators and representatives, as well as the addresses for Mr. Mosbacher and Mr. Wilson. Remember that individual letters mean more than "form letters", so use a bit of originality when you write your letters.

### 1920 and 1930 FEDERAL CENSUSES

The following is found on the 1920 and 1930 U.S. censuses. The 1920 census will be released for public search about 1992. (From Comput-Serv computer network via National Archives.)

1920: Street address; house no.; family no.; name of person; relationship to head; sex; color or race; age, last birthday; marital status; if foreign born; yr. of immigration to U. S.; whether naturalized; yr. of naturalization; school attendance; literacy; birthplace of person and parents; native tongue if foreign born; ability to speak English; occupation; industry and class of worker; home rented or owned; if owned, whether mortgaged; for non-farm mortgaged, market value; original amount of mortgage, balance due, interest rate.

1930: Address; name; relationship to family head; home owned or rented; value of monthly rental; radio set; whether on a farm; sex;; race; age; martial status; age at first marriage; school attendance; literacy; birth place of person and parents; if foreign born, language spoken in home before coming to U. S.; yr. of immigration, whether naturalized, and ability to speak English; occupation, industry and class of worker; whether at work previous day (or last regular working day); veteran status; for Indians, whether of full or mixed blood, and tribal affiliation.
