

The log cabin at California Mesa, Olathe, Colorado is not there any more, that was were Iris Joan Krogh was born January 10, and the doctor that delivered her came from Delta, not too far away. Her name "Iris" was a favorite of her fathers. And there were other relatives with names starting with "I" as well. Her mother, father and three brothers (she was the only girl and the youngest of her siblings) lived all over Delta County and moved to Grand Junction when she was in Junior High School. She remembers her first job working at the Copeland Drug Store on 5<sup>th</sup> and Main Street in downtown Grand Junction, as a "soda Jerk", earning 70 cents an hour.

Soon after Iris and David were married, they left Colorado and lived in numerous different parts of the United States. David worked for General Electric and was always being transferred. She and David have been married now for 52 years. They have three children; two boys who live in Colorado and one daughter that lives in Alabama. Iris worked at a temporary job agency for a number of years. She also attended college, going to night school, but never was able to get her degree as there seemed to always be too many interruptions along the way.

She joined Mesa County Genealogical Society in the 1990's but, has been researching since the 1980's. She is a member of the German American Club and enjoys belonging to a quilting club.
